

MULTIPLIER EVENT / SUSTAINABLE SERVICE IN DS



This October, the multiplier event of the Asindown Foundation took place, where the results of the work carried out over two years were presented: Sustainable Service in DS or, Service Learning, SDGs and people with Down Syndrome.

With this event, the ERASMUS+ SUSTAINABLE SERVICE IN DS project with file number 2020-1-RO01-KA204-080306 is closed and future actions are expected to replicate what has been established in this project.

An Erasmus+ programme that consists of, through the Service Learning methodology, the implementation of actions based on the SDGs and the 2030 agenda.

The Service Learning methodology consists of 7 distinct steps in which people with Down syndrome and/or intellectual disabilities are key actors who make decisions and design their own roadmap.

Step 1: Awareness of the SDGs and the 2030 agenda

Step 2: Knowledge of the Service Learning methodology.

Step 3: Search for needs in the immediate environment linked to the SDGs. Conclusions, reflection and decision making on what action to implement.

Step 4: Establishing a PLAN and seeking support for its implementation.

Step 5: Development of the action

Step nº6: Conclusions and communication of what has been carried out.

Step nº7: Celebration and closing.

The event was attended by more than 30 entities with different profiles: private companies, public administration, universities and NGO staff.

We also had the participation of more than 50 users with Down syndrome and/or intellectual disabilities who shared their experiences and participated in an open debate on possible needs

and future Service Learning actions to be implemented with regard to the SDGs and the 2030 agenda.

During four hours, the different tools created for training both professionals and teachers as well as the students themselves were presented. Training manuals adapted to intellectual disabilities and with a clear explanation of the Sustainable Development Goals and the 2030 agenda.

The e-learning platform on which our users have worked and which reflects the decision-making and learning process of the people with Down syndrome and/or intellectual disabilities who have participated was also presented.

At the end of the event, we had a catering for the almost 200 people who attended, where we tasted our Genetically Rebellious wine and had a Photocall with users and invited companies.
